Project Hometown Help Allocates Funds

A total of 273 allocations were made to various agencies and organizations totaling \$217,580 through Middle Tennessee Natural Gas Utility District's Project Hometown Help from January 2020 through December 2020. The amount of funds disbursed in each county is determined by the level of participation in the Project Hometown Help program within that county.

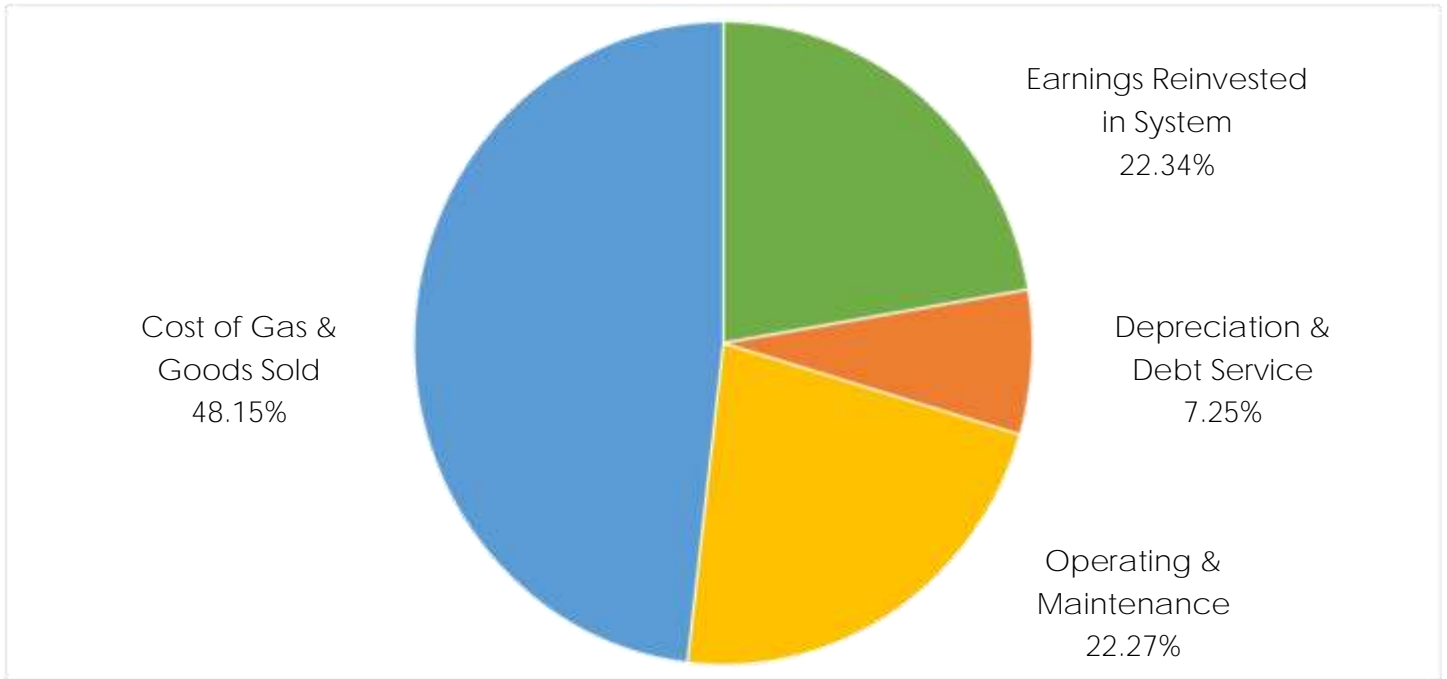
